My greatest achievement is... being able to do what I do - well, have my children and remain semisane!


My greatest regret is... I don't really have any - I use the past to help project the future.

Renee Mason

Castles, ski lodges and a classroom in China – they're all part of the life experiences of our speaker at the August meeting, Beaudesert branch librarian Renee Mason.

Renee was brought up on a farm at Moogerah and returned from working in Darwin to live at Boonah when the job at Beaudesert was offered to her, but in between times she has covered many thousands of kilometres in pursuit of her three passions - teaching, librarianship and travel.

Most recently she returned from a Rotary-sponsored group study tour to Hong Kong and Macau and is currently working with Rotary Beaudesert in setting up a multi-purpose room for community use at the Beaudesert library.

Renee trained as a History/English teacher before "escaping" to Scotland for three years soon after graduation and working in both education and the tourism industry, jobs which involved romantic settings such as the Isle of Skye, ski lodges and castles.

She later worked in a school at Alice Springs where, she says, the librarian was a "huge, hairy guy, the antithesis of the little old lady librarian stereotype." It was this contact which inspired her to take up study for her Masters of Education in teacher/librarianship. During her Masters study she lived in China and worked at an International school.

Renee will give us a contemporary view of the place of the library in society and the changing needs which librarians must meet, as well as an outline of her current goals at the library in Beaudesert.

Progress in Ethiopia

A recent BKFA visit to Ethiopia by Di Bartel and Ruth Jackson revealed just how well our work is going in that country. Three Non-Government Organisations, Abraham's Oasis, the Afar Peoples Development Agency (APDA) and the Hamlin Fistula Hospital, are all making their own birthing kits, with the BKFA providing back up supplies from Australia if required. This creates much needed employment for disadvantaged women and avoids the cost and challenges of kit supply, especially in the wet season when even air freight cannot make it to some areas. Each region of Ethiopia has its own challenges. The APDA for example, produces kits for the traditional Afar women living a pastoral and nomadic way of life. They move with their herds according to the landscape, availability of water, pasture and other resources and the supply and kit contents are adjusted accordingly. Despite substantial government investment in resources for clean delivery and training to improve the skills of the local Health Extension Workers in many health facilities in Ethiopia, there is still an inadequate supply of equipment. About 90% of Ethiopian women still give birth at home so the need for clean home delivery kits remains. Women are starting to demand a 'clean sheet' delivery and even health facilities want birthing kits in the absence of other basic equipment and suitable clean supplies. In another pleasing development all three NGOs have been able to implement health programs beyond the reach of existing government services. This round of production was funded by AusAID, and takes the BKFA another step closer to our long term goal of programme sustainability in Ethiopia.
